## FULL TRANSCRIPT

Johnson County BLS 67. Good evening, Community Hospital. This is Johnson County BLS 67. We're currently en route to your facility in non-emergent. On board we have an 85-year-old male, that's an 85-year-old male, coming to you from home. Chief complaint per family is going to be altered mental status. Last known normal was yesterday evening before going to bed. Family states that the patient was hard to wake this morning and has been progressively getting altered throughout the day. I'm giving him a GCS of 13-14. He is not answering alert-oriented questions. He is alert, eyes are opening spontaneously, he's able to move. He's got no unilateral deficits. Vitals are stable. I've got a pulse rate of, left pulse rate was 65, blood pressure 159 over 65, S2 is 95% on your mirror. We did get an axillary temperature of 101.4. He also does have a runny nose. Patient states that he does have end-stage leukemia and that he has a patient with you guys. We're coming over the connector now, so we'll be there in probably about 8 minutes. Any questions, any orders? Do you have a BGL? Affirmative, my apologies. 122, BGL 122.
